Criteria for Clinical Associate Professor from FOM Policy on Clinical Faculty Appointments (updated February 2020)

Appointments at this rank may be made for up to 10 years, renewable upon review. A candidate for appointment, reappointment, or promotion to this rank will meet the criteria of the lower rank as well as some or all of the following:

- 1. Has consistently received good formal teaching evaluations.
- 2. Has the reputation of being a highly competent clinician.
- 3. Has developed expertise within his or her own field, which may include an area of special professional skill.
- 4. Has taken an active, prominent role in provincial or territorial and national professional organizations.
- 5. Has contributed significantly to the administration and/or service activities of his or her hospital, agency, professional organization, FOM or UBC.
- 6. Has been called upon to speak at professional society meetings, in continuing professional educational programs and at other institutions.
- 7. Participates in research as a primary investigator or in collaborative studies (not required).
- ** For reappointment and promotion, will have provided more than 50 hours of academic contribution over a two-year period
