At the completion of the scholarly activity project, residents will be able to:

1. Pose a scholarly question with a testable hypothesis.
2. Select and apply an appropriate study method and design.
3. Determine the ethical obligations for the project.
4. Conduct a systematic literature search using publicly available databases.
5. Synthesize the literature using critical appraisal.
6. Apply appropriate statistical methods.
7. Present their findings in a scientific format (oral or poster) at a regional, national, or international conference.
8. Report their findings and conclusions in a written paper format suitable for publication.
