1. **Describe the epidemiology and natural history of methamphetamine-associated psychosis**, including prevalence and risk of recurrence or persistence.
2. **Recognize clinical features that increase or decrease the likelihood of a primary psychotic disorder in patients with methamphetamine-associated psychosis**, including patterns of onset, symptom persistence after abstinence, and premorbid or family risk factors.
3. **Outline evidence-based management of methamphetamine-associated psychosis**, including acute stabilization, indications for antipsychotic use, and longer-term treatment consistent with the ASAM 2024 Guidelines.
